

Book Bag

An original pattern by The Knitting Fairy®

Finished size: 11" X 14" Handle may be sewn to desired length.

Materials Needed:

3 skeins Cascade 220 or other non-superwashed worsted weight wool Black (#8555)

1 skein each Cascade 220 (Dark Grey #8400, Light Grey #8401, Dark Red #2401, Bright Red #8414, Turquoise #7812)

US #13 Needles

Gauge: 3 sts = 1 inch in stockinette stitch with yarn held double. Gauge is not critical for this project.

Handle:

Double I-Cord: With black held double, Cast on 7 sts and work in double I-cord as follows:

Row 1: K4, yf, slip 3 knitwise. Turn.

Repeat row 1 until piece measures 55 inches. Bind off by threading the cut end of the yarn through the I-corded sides in a figure 8 and pulling tight.

Bag:

With black held double, cast on 36 sts.

Row 1: Purl.

Row 2: Knit.

Repeat the last 2 rows until 73 rows have been worked, ending with a Purl row.

Change to Bright Red held double and continue in stockinette stitch as established for 4 rows.

With these stitches and continuing with yarn held double, begin working front according to chart starting at bottom right hand corner through row 78. Bind off loosely. Weave in ends, sew side seams and attach handles on the outside near tops of both seams.
